Distance running in 2009 continues to see record fields in lots of fun runs and state championship events. As a club we are also enjoying an increase in membership. On the opening day of our winter cross country season on 28th March we had 102 runners enjoying good competition with all the trimmings we have come to enjoy at Scarborough Park – on days like these you just know it is going to be a good year!

A few weeks after the season started we had Tim Rowe, one of our top athletes, making his marathon debut in Canberra finishing in 2nd spot with a time of 2.27.01. Tim was also raising funds for the National Breast Cancer Foundation and raised the sum of \$6,300. Tim went on to have a super year being part of our open male NSW CC relay team with Ben St Lawrence, Chadi Elashkar and Stephen Thurston – taking out 1st place.

In NSW State championship our club continues its fine tradition of picking up medals. Frank Scorzelli leads the way joined by Jose Carvalho, Veronica Wallington, Belinda Martin, Lyn Delaney also joined by our under 12 males, 45+ males and 65+ males' teams.

Teams are one of the hardest jobs to manage for a club, our team selectors do a fine job of this and enjoyed success for their efforts. As mentioned before the NSW CC relays will be remembered for a long time not just for the terrible conditions but for the way our open male team dominated from start to finish in winning gold for the first time in seven years.

The biggest fun run of the year (if we can call it that) attracted a record field of 76,254 people with our clubs' outstanding senior athlete Ben St Lawrence taking 2nd position and was joined by 24 clubs members a little further back in the field. Ben also managed a successful international campaign, as did Tim Rowe and Bridey Delaney.

Looking back on the year 2009, it was encouraging to see that we are attracting and keeping younger members who are happy with the good competition on offer at Scarborough Park. We continue to see the NSW Novice championships to be the biggest and best organized event on ANSW calendar and our own Rockdale City Council fun run continues to promote our club to the local community. We continue to support our athletes and look forward to the future with excitement and confidence.

2009 /2010 Track and Field Report

Full highlights of another successful track and field season for SGDAC are given below.

Firstly I like to thank all SGDAC club members for helping make it a great T & F season again. From my view I firmly believe any of our athletes who entered into any event this Year wearing our Club Colours help formed the one team, competing for one of the finest Athletic clubs in this country. The Heritage, traditions and sprit of this Club run deep thru all those who continue to compete, help or barrack for our club in any shape or formed. To be a winner in our club you don't have to win any event at all, any competitor or supporter of our club make them a winner anyway.

Still our club does most certainly have our share of outstanding achievers from Club level, state, National and even a few competing with worthy results at the International level.

Once again this Year Ben St Lawrence in winning a national title and Bridey Delaney achieving a second place at national both have achieved success at the top level. With Ben already gaining automatic selection into the 2010 Commonwealth Games, to be held in New Delhi in October later this Year. While Bridey still with a chance to make this team is still continuing her quest to gain the required qualifying time needed is heading to compete on the European circuit.

Another state title won by to Belinda Martin in the 5000m event and also Bridey winning the state 3000m and 1500m titles. A rundown of all our National & State titles including age division's medals won by our club competitors goes like this – at National level 1 gold medal and 3 Silver medals attained. At State 16 Gold medals attained, 10 silver medals attained & 14 bronze medals.

At the state ANSW Relays our club results gave us 4 Gold medal teams, 1 silver medal & 3 bronze medals were attained multiply this by four competitors in each team. (See separate report below)

End result all together our club competitors picked up 72 medals in the track & Field season. Also during this season we have to date 10 individual Club records broken & 1 relay team record. All these record-breaking results in fact all our Track & Field results are listed below. I hope you get to see and enjoy all these as they show the actual valued effort full results of all our club competitors.

Please also review the individual reports on all our special 2009 / 2010 award winners.

Sixty-one competitors in total this year competed in the red and white colours in a variety of events.

Sadly only 18 of our competitors competed in the 4 Club premierships events. The point's scores can also be seen below. Our strongest group again this year were mostly under 20 or in younger age groups. It would be great to have more open competitors and all other age competitors competing. It really it's all good fun.

On a Sad note our condolences go out to the Auciello family with the sudden passing away of Tony Auciello last year, Tony still hold 5 of our Club distance records in the Male U16, U18 & U20

NSW State Relays Report 2009 - 21-22/11/09 - NSW Relay Championships

St George Results

A deserved well done and special thanks to all SGDAC competitors who turned up to compete and represent our Club at State Relays held last weekend Sat 21st and 22nd November at Blacktown Olympic Park. Additional thanks also to all the supporters who turned up to cheer on family and friends in this competition, and also Jim Gallagher who gave valuable assistance over the weekend. Extremely hot conditions were the order of the day for both days of competition. When the temperature hit the mid 40 degrees on the second day of competition ANSW had to wisely make a safety call and cancel all the 1500M relay races and also 1600 Sprint Medley (8,4,2,2) open finals. A fair bit of disappointment for some of the keener competitors at first, but on reflection it was widely accepted that the right decision had been made by ANSW.

Our Club members achieved some outstanding results on the two days - the temperature was running hot and so were our women's field teams. They managed to claim 3 gold and 4 bronze medal positions.

Alix Kennedy broke her own U18 and Open Women's Discus Club Records with a tremendous throw resulting in a New Club Record of **46.32m**. This beat her previous records of 44.83m (All Schools, 5-8 Nov 09) and the record attained last season of 44.14m (30/11/08). This throw was only 62cm off the Qualifying Distance required to meet the initial selection requirement for the **World Junior Championships** to be held in **Moncton, Canada in July 2010**.

Our U18 Women's Javelin Throw Relay Gold medal winning team with a total of **134.70m** were only **30cm** off breaking the State Record.

There were also some good results achieved by our relay teams on the track, especially when you considered some late formations were required to help field some of these teams. I would like to acknowledge our Club Track Captain Chris Barakat and his fellow track athletes - Stephen Smith, Scott Manns, Kerry Cree and Paul Windridge - who not only performed well on the track in the Open Men's 100m and 200m heats as well as coming 6th in the Open men's long jump, but also assisted in setting up our base on both days.

As mentioned earlier, the withdrawal of the 1500m relay races was a disappointment for a number of our competitors although a few of the late recruits might have been a little relieved. Take the sporting gestures of our webmaster Michael Gentle, a late call to help form one of the 1500m relay teams, who had already ran a half marathon in the morning and his son Aaron who had completed a 10 K was also on standby as reserve for the U20 1500m team. Not forgetting Trish Simpson who had volunteered to make up the position in one of the 200+ male 1500m teams after a very late request even with a couple of painful blisters on one foot.

Our U20 800m Relay team came in 6th place with some young runners mixed in to formed this team - Tim Hogan, Thomas Delaney, Riley Delaney and 12 year old Mark Simpson who ran the final leg giving it his all on the day for his team. Our two 200+ 800m relay teams really put plenty of red and whites on the track, with all putting in their best efforts resulting in a 4th and 12th position in this event. Sean Hogan, Dale Jones, Jose Carvalho, Kim Delaney, John Irvine, David Burns, Peter Fitzpatrick and Bob Simpson made up these teams. While on Sunday afternoon Frank Scorcelli in 1500m 200+ team and Daniel Siepen 1500m U20 team were both set to race when the extreme temperature at the time meant the race had to be cancelled.

Finally the biggest thanks must go to all the St George Coaches whose time and dedication is the main reason our Club performed so successfully over the weekend - with special mention to the brilliance of Ray Russell and Michelle Douglas whose athletes performed so marvelously on both days.

SUMMER CROSS COUNTRY REPORT

With the weather on the whole being kind to us, another successful season of summer cross country was held over 17 weeks on Wednesday evenings from late October through to end of February, with the venue alternating between Scarborough Park and Gannon's Park, as in previous years.

The change in registration requirements didn't have a major noticeable effect on numbers competing and we were only slightly down on the previous year as shown below.

In the 2Km Division Emma Millett built a clear lead in the handicap points competition, however the margin reduced in the later weeks of the season, as Trish Simpson closed to within 5 points, with new member Jamie Bryant coming through to take third.

In the longer races held over either 3km or 4km Sean Hogan, who continues to improve, was a clear winner, while David Beck and last year's winner, Chris Maver, took the other trophies.

In the Fastest Times category for the 2km Females, last year's joint winner, Emma Millett, won again -this time by a wide margin. Likewise in the division 1 Male fastest times Kim Delaney repeated last year's success, again scoring well ahead of the rest.

Thomas Delaney missed many of the races after Christmas due to an injury but returned late in the season to snatch the Male 2Km Fastest Times trophy from Sean Hogan and Nikolay Nikolaev.

In the longer races the female trophy was only decided on the last day, with front runners Lucy Stewart and Ana Eftimova missing some runs late in the season while Kerry Edwards ran every week and was rewarded by taking first place -but by only 3 points.

Congratulations to the trophy winners and many thanks to all runners who took part and made the season a success. Particular thanks to all those who helped with the organisation, by giving out place cards, recording names, putting out flags and cones etc, in particular special thanks to Kim Delaney, Chris Mullen, Sean Hogan Trish & Bob Simpson, Emma Millett & Kerry Edwards. 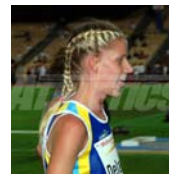

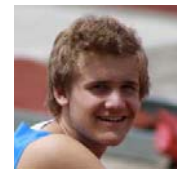

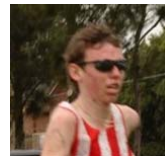

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Changes to the fee structure to register members with Athletics NSW have resulted in inappropriate comparisons over time, and the best basis for comparisons between years is to be made by age groupings.

In 2009 the registration dates set by Athletics NSW changed to a twelve monthly period ending on 30th September. The next reporting period ends on 30th September 2010, so the figures in this report remain the same as those published in the report for the previous year.

In 2008-09 Club member numbers increased by five. During 2008-09, the Club received 41 new members and had renewals, compared to 41 new members and 129 renewals for the previous year. Details of 2008-09 new and renewal members are shown below, indicating a higher retention rate across teenagers and older members –
